For Collier County High School Graduates

1. **Fill out and send in an application for the Naples Press Club Scholarship by March 31.** Applications are available online at the Naples Press Club website: [www.naplespressclub.org](http://www.naplespressclub.org), under the SCHOLARSHIPS category. Applications are also available by contacting the NPC Scholarship Chairman, Connie Kindsvater, at [conskind@aol.com](mailto:conskind@aol.com) or 239-249-4969. (Note: If an applicant needs more time because of a special situation, please make that known.)
2. Collier County high school graduates may apply, including current 2018 graduates and graduates from prior years.

4. Applicants will be interviewed by the Naples Press Club Scholarship Committee to help determine which applicants will be awarded NPC Scholarships.
5. Students must be planning to attend (or currently attending) an accredited institution of higher learning, pursuing a 4-year accredited degree program, a 2-year accredited program leading to a 4-year undergraduate degree, or a 2-year accredited degree program.
6. Students must be planning (or currently pursuing) a major or minor in the overall field of Journalism/Media Studies. Acceptable studies include Journalism, Mass Communications, Media Communications, Media Studies, Communication Studies, TV/Radio Broadcasting, Electronic Media, Multimedia Communication or Photo-Journalism.
7. NPC Annual \$1,000 Journalism Scholarships are renewable, provided that the Scholarship Student meets the continuing criteria:
  - a. Maintains at least a B (3.0) GPA (Grade Point Average).
  - b. Continues to be a full-time student in an accredited institution of higher learning.
  - c. Continues to pursue a major or minor in the overall field of journalism/media studies.
  - d. Internships/Hands-on Journalism Experience are encouraged: such as being on the staff of the school newspaper, magazine, radio station, TV station, internet news or sports channel, and completing at least one official journalism internship with college credits given, while a student.
8. Special Opportunities for NPC Scholarship Students:
  - a. Each Scholarship Student is given a Naples Press Club Mentor.
  - b. Each Scholarship Student is awarded an Honorary Student Naples Press Club Membership, which includes attendance at NPC meetings at no cost to the student.
  - c. Networking opportunities are available with members of the Naples Press Club, working and retired men and women in the overall fields of journalism and media, plus non-fiction authors. NPC members also try to help students find, apply for and secure internships in the overall journalism/media studies field.
